

Guidelines and Information

1. Camps are to be set up within your site boundaries. This includes awnings, tension cords, equipment and vehicles. Any noncompliance will result in payment for second site.
2. Camp fires in provided fire rings only.
3. When you leave, please bag all garbage and deposit in cans situated throughout the park. Do not leave it at your site.
4. Dispose of gray water and sewage at appropriate dump stations. State law prohibits dumping waste on ground.
5. All electric campsites have 50 amp service.
6. TV cable can be acquired at office. A 50' cord is available with a \$10 deposit.
7. Firearms must be unloaded and kept in owner's vehicle at all times.
8. Any excessive noise coming from boom boxes, TVs, radios, etc. is prohibited. Anyone not in compliance will be asked to leave. Please be respectful of others camping around you.
9. Speed limit is 10 m.p.h. State and local traffic laws apply on all park roads.
10. No off-road vehicle riding in the park.
11. Pets - cats and dogs only. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Waste must be picked up and disposed of properly. Animals should never be left unattended at the campsite.
12. Please do not remove picnic tables. (*One table per site.*)
13. Quiet time is 11pm to 7am. No through traffic or use of park facilities during this time.
14. Gates at east and west end of park will be closed to through traffic from 11pm to 8am. The main entrance by the park office is open 24 hours.
15. Coin showers are available in both bath houses.
16. Computer access is available in park office. There is a charge of \$3 per half hour for computer use.
17. Optional individual pumpout service is available at campsites every Tuesday. \$15 charge.
18. Check-out time is 12:30 pm.

Park management reserves the right to evict anyone found breaking the rules, damaging our property, or causing discomfort to other campers, with no refund. Management assumes no responsibility for accidents, injuries, or loss of property.

Woodland Park is located on the shores of Lake Superior, the park is only three blocks from the main business area, marina, swimming beaches; adjacent to the Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore; and only steps from agate beach.

Woodland Park is a municipally owned and operated campground containing 114 sites in the main camping area, and a secluded primitive camping area which will accommodate an additional 19 campers.

Facilities include two fully equipped bath houses, beach access, gray water and sewage dump station, dishwashing stations and a drinking water fill station.

Adjacent to the park is the recreational area, which includes tennis courts, basketball court, baseball/softball diamond, tot lot, horseshoe pits and a pavilion for family picnics.

We take pride in our town and in our campground. We hope your stay will be pleasant, and that you will continue to return to Grand Marais.
